

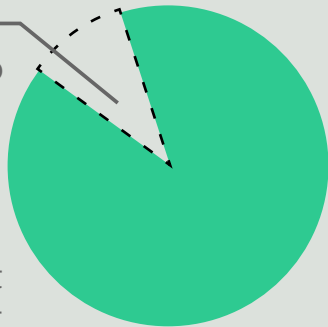
# Austerity for Working People

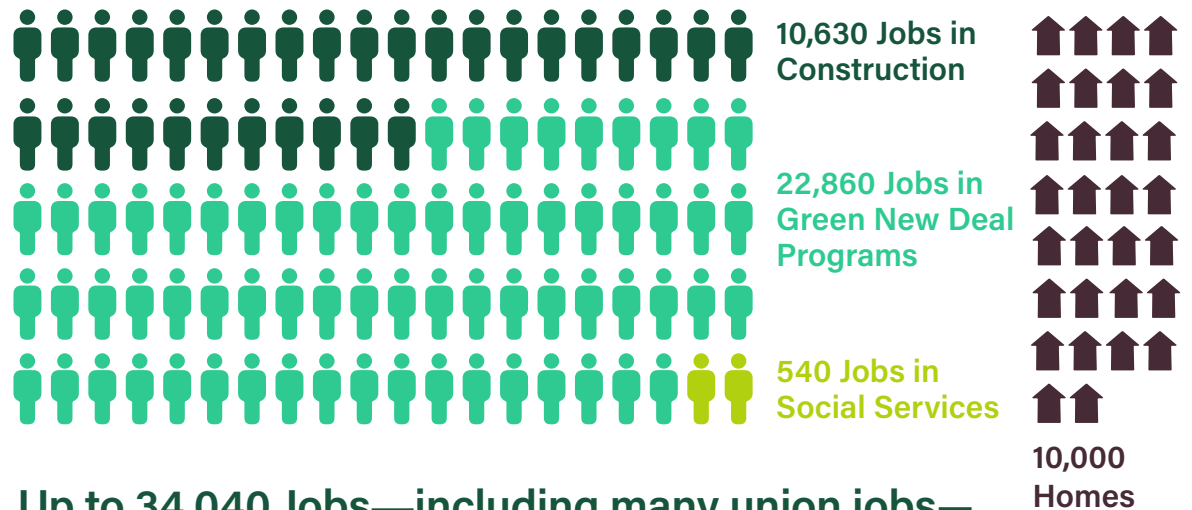
# Tax Big Business for Jobs + Social Housing
